This matter comes before the court on Defendant United States of America's motion to seal, [DE-672], Defendant's Memorandum in Opposition to Plaintiffs' Motion to Exclude Defense Expert Dr. Harold J. Bursztajn and attachments found at [DE-668]. The court has provided adequate notice to the public and opportunity for interested parties to object. The Plaintiffs' Leadership Group did not oppose Defendant's provisional filing under seal, *see* [DE-672] 1, and no objection to the motion has been filed.

The information sought to be sealed is sensitive medical information from plaintiffs in this litigation. The court finds that sealing is necessary to advance a significant interest that outweighs the public's right of access and that no alternative to sealing would adequately protect such interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

(1) Defendant's motion [DE-672] is GRANTED, as set forth in this Order;

(2) The documents and attachments filed at [DE-668] SHALL BE MAINTAINED
UNDER SEAL pending further order of the court.
